#### What We Did

From January 1 - December 31, 2024, we served **444 unique children** and their families.

We provided these families with:

- 1,416 packs of diapers
- · 1,291 packs of wipes
- 219 cans of formula
- 46 new baby gift baskets
- · 413 pieces of used baby equipment
- 91 cars seats (including 8 boosters)
- 89 other safety items
- 320 toys
- Nearly 2,700 hours of volunteer service given.
